Resource Adequacy

- June Decision: Limit on CCA Expansion
 - o 1% deficiency threshold will "pause" a CCA's ability to expand
 - Ability to cure
 - Timing:
 - Accruals begin: July 2023 (August Month-Ahead)
 - Assessments begin: September 2023 (Month-Ahead) and October 2023 (Year-Ahead)
- Next steps: Massive jurisdictional overreach?





Provider of Last Resort

- Status: Briefing stage for Phase 1 (October 2023 decision anticipated)
- SDG&E and CalCCA positions on:
 - Service requirements
 - Changes to financial security requirement and reentry fees
- Phase 2: Will build on Phase 1 to set the requirements and application process for non-utility entities to serve as the provider of last resort





Quick Hits

- Power Charge Indifference Adjustment: Main rulemaking closed (after six years), but the fight continues: Energy Resource Recovery Account proceedings and General Rate Cases, among others
- Net Billing Tariff: Application for Rehearing denied; appeal persists; new tariff still moving forward
